Curated by Miami-based Diana Lowenstein Fine Arts Gallery, which also compiled EPIC Residences' 100-piece, \$2 million, museum-quality art collection, the Matta display at the EPIC VIP Lounge featured several works by the artist from the period 1985 to 1994. Worth nearly \$400,000 in total, the works, which had not been on public display in some time, included oil on canvas, mixed media on paper, and lithographs.



EPIC's VIP Lounge gave show-goers a place to appreciate and enjoy Matta's distinctive modern style in an intimate and relaxed setting while also experiencing the EPIC lifestyle.
